

# Hebrew & Religious School and Teen Program COVID19 Teacher Madrichim Additional Information

as of September 5, 2021; subject to revision

All CBH Teachers and Madrichim are expected to review and comply with our official COVID19 Protocol concerning Education & Youth Programs. This page is intended to supplement and support us in following those protocols.

### **Daily Schedules:**

For Religious School (Sunday morning), our Family Service will remain on Zoom until the pandemic situation improves and the vaccine is available for younger children. All teachers and madrichim are expected to fully participate (video on) in the Family Zoom Service from in their classroom. Preparation for your teaching is to be completed prior to the start of the Family Service. Students will begin to arrive between 10:10 and 10:30 a.m. All teachers should prepare independent activities such as simple art projects, games, reflection questions, stories, etc. to fill this time in a meaningful way. Your set induction and full lesson may begin as soon as most of your students arrive, no later than 10:30 a.m. Thank you in advance for your flexibility in supporting this transition. In following this protocol, our schedule will be as follows:

Family Service (Zoom) 9:30-10:00 a.m.
Student Campus Arrival 10:10-10:30 a.m.
Classroom Instruction 10:30 a.m. -12:00 p.m.

Our **Hebrew School schedule remains the same on Wednesday afternoons from 2:00-4:00 p.m.** There is a small group of students who will be participating in either private or semi-private Hebrew lessons on **Wednesdays from 4:00-5:00 p.m.** 

**Teen Space Time** has temporarily been reduced and will meet from 6:00-6:30 p.m. on the Sundays when Keshet and Confirmation Classes are in session.

In order to reduce the number of children using our playground equipment, gaga pit, basketball area, etc., we will be utilizing the following recess schedule:

## Cleaning & Hygiene Protocols: Hand Washing:

Upon arrival, all teachers, madrichim, children, teens and any visitors should wash their hands thoroughly. Proper handwashing is encouraged as a regular practice while on our campus. Each Teacher Box will have a bottle of hand sanitizer to be used as needed.

#### **Air Purifiers, Windows & Doors:**

In preparation for our safe return as well as the reopening of our Gan Haverim preschool in July 2020, many improvements have been made to the HVAC system and overall ventilation. We were blessed to receive funding from Healthy Davis Together allowing us to purchase high quality air purifiers for all learning and gathering spaces. Our HVAC system as well as the air filters are inspected and filters are changed on a frequent basis. All windows and doors have been repaired or upgraded as needed. Upon arrival, teachers should turn on all air purifiers in their learning spaces. In addition, weather permitting, windows and doors should remain open to increase the efficiency of air circulation.

It is the responsibility of each teacher to ensure that all windows are securely closed, air purifiers are turned off, and doors are fully closed at the end of Hebrew or Religious School as well as any Teen Program. If you have turned on the heat or air conditioning in your learning space, it is also your responsibility to turn it off before you leave the classroom.

#### **Disinfecting & Sanitizing:**

Upon arrival, teachers and madrichim are expected to wipe down chairs, alternative furniture options, and frequently touched classroom surfaces. Disinfecting wipes will be provided in your Teacher Box. Please let Ardyth know when you anticipate needing a refill.

#### **Creative Furniture Options & Outside Learning Spaces:**

In order to allow more flexibility in using our learning spaces, we have purchased creative furniture options such as lap desks, small portable writing tables, individual tables, clipboards, etc. This protocol will allow students to maintain more physical distancing and can also be taken to our outside learning spaces. Each grade level will have a large Rubbermaid furniture storage box that will need to be brought to your classroom and returned to the office. Since most of our classrooms are used for other things during the week, it is essential that you return your furniture box to the office at the end of your session.

When possible, please consider taking your class outside, if weather and AQI allow us to do so in a healthy manner. It may not be possible for all classes to be outside for the entire session as there may not be enough appropriate spaces. For a variety of reasons, we will not be using the grassy area on Anderson Road nor any parking lot areas as learning spaces.

#### Food & Drink Protocol:

In order to maintain proper use of face masks, we will not be serving challah, grape juice, or any snack food while on campus for Hebrew & Religious School. We will not be able to engage in any food activity or preparation related to our learning while this protocol is in place. It is our hope that this protocol can change as the pandemic situation improves and the vaccine is available for younger children. Teen Space pizza time (abbreviated) and DRTY food are currently permitted when weather and air quality allow for eating outside. This protocol is based on an assumption that participating teens are fully vaccinated.
